Invitation to Coach Scholastic Chess

Free training for your chess coach certification.

Inland Chess Academy is in need of chess club coaches for the after-school chess club programs.

One hour scholastic chess clubs meet once weekly at area schools. The Inland Chess Academy program includes a 15 minute lecture/study period and 40 minutes of tournament style chess play. During the school year fifteen regional chess tournaments are offered on Saturdays for all students and school club teams to compete. These are State qualifying tournaments.

The chess club sessions are 8 to 12 weeks and offers a stipend of \$25 per coaching hour.

In order to become a certified Inland Chess Academy Coach, a person must complete thirty hours of classroom study and perform three in-service practice sessions. Inland Chess Academy will provide ample scheduling opportunity for all candidates to complete the ten sessions and acquire certification. There is no cost for the certification program.

First-Aid/CPR certification is required (paid for by ICA). United States Chess Federation Club Tournament Directorships are also required. Inland Chess Academy will provide the current USCF rule book, test, and application forms.

This opportunity to coach chess to elementary children within a proven, structured, and safe program is beneficial for everyone: children, parents, coaches, schools, and the community.
