Schedule: Check in 9:00 am to 9:30 am. First round begins at 10:00 am.

Players arriving after 9:30 am will not be paired in the first round. Rounds 2-5 will begin within 15 minutes of the completion of the last game of the prior round.

Awards ceremony immediately follows completion of the fifth game.

Awards usually are completed before 4:00 pm.

**Format:** Scholastic Sections: Five round Swiss. G/30. All students play all five games. Divisions

are set by directors after registration has been completed. All tournaments will have an elementary beginner's section. Tournaments are rated by the Northwest Rating Service. *USCF Section:* Four games G/40, d5. USCF membership required. Membership forms at

registration table. Memberships will be processed during tournament.

**Medical:** Please notify registration desk regarding potential medical issues with players.

**Byes may be requested.** Students are encouraged to get as much tournament play as their schedules permits. Rules of chess, sportsmanship, camaraderie, and team building are benefits learned while attending tournaments.
